The Customer

The Affordable Art Fair in Battersea Park is one of London's leading showcases for accessible contemporary art.

The Challenge

The customer required an interesting and unique backdrop for their outdoor seating area, which would be visited by many thousands of artists and art lovers. It would have to be warm and inviting enough to appeal to tired visitors, as well as unique and fitting to its stylish surroundings.

The Solution

To fulfill this criteria, Mykon's sales team recommended the new colour series range.

These panels are made with a coloured core encased between strong polycarbonate or glass skins, meaning there is a large number of variations available.

After liaising with the Affordable Art Fair, the team recommended placing lighting behind the panels. The light would be diffused through the organic fish-eye cells.

The Outcome

The pink coloured core supplied by Mykon provided a visually stunning background to visitors to the fair. When lit from behind, the core emitted a subtle glow. Mykon also provided pressload planters to add to the unusual effect.
